Resource Development Team

- The VNW fund raising campaign is still on-track for November. We have not heard about the personalization for Viva Village yet.
- An artistic member would like to have an art show, in conjunction with other Viva Village Artists, to sell his works and donate monies to the village. The Governing Council agreed to this. Timing to be determied but likely next spring. Karen will manage this.

Outreach and Publicity Team

• The team is working on a new printed brochure and is reviewing photos and wording, incorporating suggestions from Village Movement California.

Volunteer Team

- The team recommends the following office hours for upcoming holidays:

- The Volunteer team is discussing how to show our appreciation to volunteers in a more substantive way than just "thank you."

Membership Team

- There will be a Membership Meeting on November 2 at 10am at Southminster Church celebrating our three years since opening for services as well reaching 100 members. The team is discussing other topics for the meeting such as the Village Movement California language use by the village, vendors and Villages NW videos
- The team is in general discussions about other member issues, among them: what to do with members that seem to "fall through the cracks"; are some members beyond the scope of our support and services and what to do when that happens.
- We had a brief discussion on the relationship between members and volunteers and expectations of each for the other. It is a fluid topic without any written guidance. Some misunderstandings were discussed.

- VNW Treasurer Zilda Huesinkveld will attend our next meeting to get to know village leaders.
- The health Fair at Elsie Stuhr had a few miscommunications that upset our volunteers. This had been discussed with both Elsie Stuhr and the involved volunteers. Next year we will pay \$200 to be included in the "passport" for the program, and the GC agreed to this.

• Larry, Kathy and Rae are rotating off the GC in April. It is important at the upcoming member meeting (on November 2) to emphasize we are looking for new members and/or volunteers to assume these roles.
