Beaverton Committee on Aging (BCOA) Report

- Members of BCOA Susana Sharp, Viva Village member/volunteer and Suzanne Van Slyke, Viva Village Volunteer reported on the purpose, activities and structure of BCOA and how it intersects with the primary goals of the City of Beaverton.
- Beaverton City goals: Enhance Livability, Improve Mobility, Create a Vibrant Downtown, Build Community and Public Service Action
- Discussion centered around how Viva Village and BCOA can work together along with collaboration with Beaverton Library and Washington County.

Resource Development: Larry

- Greatnonprofits.org was brought to our attention as a website that allows individuals to donate to their non-profit of choice. Villages NW is listed but none of the individual villages are listed. Larry to research further
- Resource Development Affinity group has researched over 40/50 grantors that may be available for villages to access. More information to come on this and how VNW and individual villages would utilize the information
- City of Beaverton grant process is open for the next 6 weeks and Viva will be submitting an application. The city will not be interviewing groups that have participated in the grant process in prior years. We are not sure of the impact or how our grant application will be handled as a result of the change.
- With new members on our Resource Development committee, they will be looking at ways to explain how Viva impacts the lives of older adults utilizing more national and local statistics.

- The Forum events have outgrown the current space. Request to move to a larger room at the Methodist church was discussed and approved temporarily. Cost for the new room is \$100 mo. Ask for further research into another facility/location that is less expensive sent back to Events team.
