- All Viva Village events will be cancelled through April 30, 2020.
- The decision to hold a Viva Village meeting (e.g. work teams, GC, etc.) will be made by the team leader but must be held by teleconference or videoconference.

- We will continue to provide services, particularly urgent services like errands to the grocery store and pharmacy. As always, volunteers and members are free to refuse services. If a member calls needing transportation urgently to a medical facility and/or is ill, they should be directed to their health provider for further assistance or told to call 911.
- A message to Members and Volunteers summarizing the previous points and containing other useful information will be developed by Kathy and Barbara and others to be sent in the next 2-3 days.
- Janet and Karen will ask our Neighborhood Connections to contact all of our members on a regular basis to be sure they have some social contact. They can be asked if any services are needed, like an errand to get groceries, etc.
- We discussed the possibility of a petty cash fund to pay for groceries, etc.
   However, after discussion we felt it would be just as easy to have the members give the errand running volunteer cash or a check to pay for these.
- Barbara Bernstein, as our only employee, will be used to help with communications, calling volunteers and possibly members, and other valuable support.
