Parks in THPRD with beautiful vistas or water features, accessible by wheelchair

These walks are all between .5 mile and .8 mile and are accessible to walkers and wheelchairs. All are in THPRD and can be found on their parks list.

The walks all have a point of interest like a beautiful vista, lake, creek or wetland. The Commonwealth Lake path is the best, has benches, and can be shortened by staying on the most beautiful side of the lake nearest the wheelchair entrance and the row of houses.

Beautiful Wheelchair Accessible Trails in THPRD - .5 to .8 miles

- 1. Commonwealth Lake Park (Foothill St./Dellwood St. entrance accessible)
- 2. Lowami Hart Woods (crosses Johnson Creek, near Murray and Hart)
- 3. Cooper Mountain Nature Park (one trail, with vista, is accessible to wheelchairs)
- 4. Koll Center Wetlands (accessible on weekends from office bldg. parking lot near Hall)
- 5. Greenway Park (Fanno Creek between Hall and Scholls Ferry)
- 6. Vista Brook Park (small lake in Raleigh Hills neighborhood off Scholls Ferry)
- 7. Bethany Lake Park (on Rock Creek near West Union and 185th)
- 8. Fanno Creek Trail (Fanno farmhouse area off of Creekside, near Hall Blvd.)
- 9. Schlottmann Creek Greenway (near Walker and 158th)
- 10. Nature Park -- Oak Trail (walk along Cedar Mill Creek, access via Millikan Way)
- 11. Nature Park -- Vine Maple Trail (wheelchair accessible to Cedar Mill Creek bridge)
- 12. Cedar Mill Falls (boardwalk to falls, park in the Cedar Mill Bible Church parking lot)
- 13. Willow Creek Greenway (boardwalk off NW Waterhouse near 158th & 26 FWY)
- 14. Molshofsky Woods (Willow creek boardwalk off NW Winged Foot Terrace)
