Prepare Materials Properly

Preparing your hazardous items for transport and disposal will minimize risks to you, your family and Metro staff from spills or dangerous mixing of chemicals.

- No containers larger than five gallons.
- Keep products in original containers.
- Do not mix products together. Dangerous reactions can occur when some materials are mixed.
- Packing:
 - Properly seal products to prevent leaks and spills. If a container is leaking, secure it in a second leak-proof container, such as an empty bucket, and make sure it stays upright.
 - Pack upright in a single layer in a sturdy, leakproof box for safe transport to event.
- Transport in trunk of car, away from driver, passengers, pets, heat, sparks, or flames.
- Bring sharps (medical syringes) in an approved sharps container.
- Be prepared to leave the container. Boxes and containers, including fuel cans, cannot be returned.

Donation Items

- Clothing and linens
- Small home appliances
- Household items: dishes, kitchenware, jewelry, knick-knacks, clean area rugs
- Miscellaneous items: tools, musical instruments, artwork, antiques
- Televisions: no older than 5 years
- Books

PLEASE:

- All items for donation should be clean and in good repair
- Clothing should be in a bag or box
- No large items—items should fit in a car
- No furniture
